\* Eruv Tavshilin- When Rosh Hashanah falls on Thursday and Friday, an eruv tavshilin is made on Wednesday. The eruv foods are held while the following blessing and declaration are recited.

One must set aside one baked and one cooked item; usually an egg or fish and a challah are used.

The eruv food is put in a safe place and the following blessing and declaration are recited

\*Baruch ata Ado-noi Elo-heinu melech ha-olam, Asher kid-shanu bi-mitzvo-tav, Vi-tzee-vanu al mitzvat eiruv. Blessed are You, the Lord our God, King of the universe, Who sanctified us with His commandments, and commanded us in the mitzvah of eiruv.

\*The following declaration must also be made describing the purpose of the *eiruv* foods

\*Bahadain aruva y'hai saray lana l-afuyay ulvashulay ulatmoonay uladlukay sraga ultakana ulmeabad kol tzracana miyoma tava l-shabta [lana ulcol Yisrael\* hadarim ba-ir haz-ut. Through this e may we be permitted to bake, cook, keep foods warm, light candles, prepare and do anything necessary on the Festival for the sake of the Sabbath [for ourselves and for all Jews\* who live in this city].

\*\* Baruch Ata... asher, keedishanu, b'mitzvotav, v'tzivanu, lehadlik, ner, shel, yomtov. Also, remember to light a 48-hr candle on Wednesday September 8<sup>th</sup> from which you will light your 2<sup>nd</sup> day Yom Tov candles and Shabbat candles

\*\*\* Regular Havdalah, only, omitting the introductory verses before and the blessings over fire and spices.
